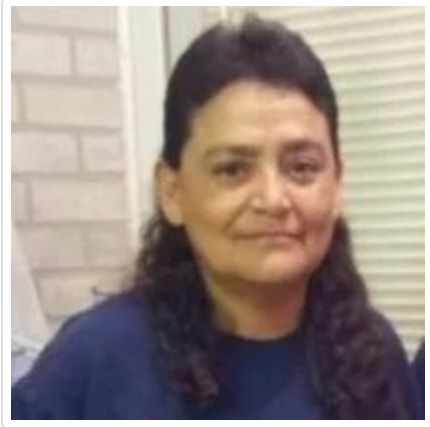




Alicia Aldaco
