Bill Wayne Anglin of Roswell passed away Friday, October 21, 2011. Bill was born on September 15, 1941 in Las Cruces, NM to parents Henry and Dorothy (Norman) Anglin. He married Jane Nunez- Smyer on July 14, 1978 and they spent 33 wonderful years together and raised 4 children.

Bill served in the Navy as a Machinist Mate in Norfolk, Virginia. After serving in the Navy, he had a variety of jobs that included working at Johnson Space Center as a Vacuum Chamber Operator, working with various electronics and communications companies where he utilized his advanced electronics training, teaching business, math, chemistry, and physics, and working at various RV Resorts in Colorado and Arizona. Bill and Jane loved to travel in their RV and met new people wherever they went. Bill obtained his Associates Degree of Applied Science Degree in Computer Information Systems from Eastern New Mexico University-Roswell and a Bachelors of Science in Geology from New Mexico State University. He was a member of the Sheriff's Posse, NM State Geological Society, Phi Theta Kappa Society and a member of the US Team Roping Championship. Bill loved to golf, fish, rope, shoot trap and skeet, and dance. He could fix anything and owned and operated several businesses over the years.
