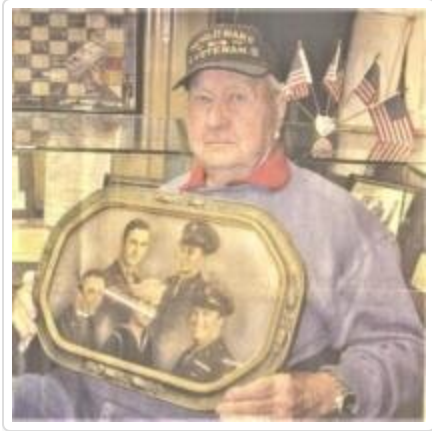




Donald Ray Southwick

Donald R. Southwick, 96, of Roswell, NM passed away on July 9, 2020 where he lived with his wife of 73 years, Ruth C. (Hartzler) Southwick.

Donald was born in Kalona, Iowa, May 16, 1924. Upon graduation from Kalona High School, he proudly served in World War II with four of his brothers where he bravely fought in Germany in the Army Artillery of B Company. After his service to his country (June 9, 1943 – March 22, 1946), he returned home and married his beloved, Ruth on January 9, 1947. They had four children, James Ray, Linda Kay, Peggy Ann, and Tommy Joe. He went to school to learn telegraph and teletype and worked for the railroad his entire career.
