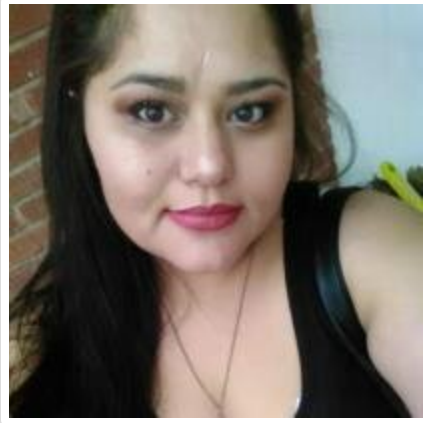




Elizabeth Ann Viola Najar
