Francisco (Pancho) Barraza Salas , 81, was surrounded by family on his passing January 31, 2026. A visitation will be held at Anderson & Bethany on February 5 at 9:00a.m., with a rosary at 6:00p.m. A Mass will be held on February 6 at 10:00 a.m. at St. John's Catholic Church. Interment will follow at South Park Cemetery, with a reception to follow at La Franciscana.

Born on July 26, 1944, to Juana & Anastasio Salas; Francisco grew up cropping with his dad and family in La Gallega Mexico. He then served in the Mexican military as a soldier before coming to the United States. He was married in Delicias, Chihuahua to Cirila Salas, and together they had four children. He was a devoted member of St. John's Catholic Church, where he was actively involved in church activities, including the cursillo retreat, and faithfully served as an usher for many years.
