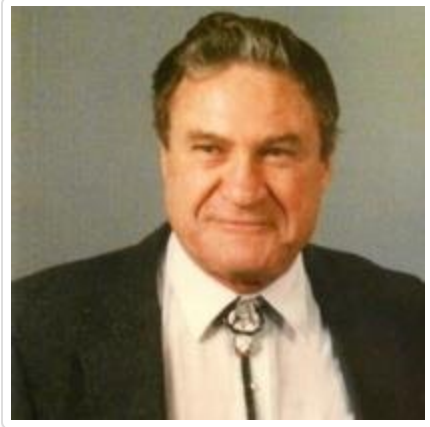




Glenn Brim
