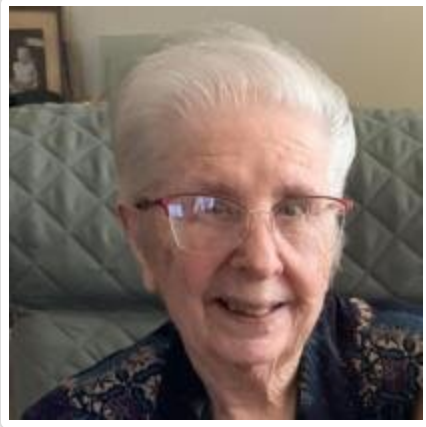




Hazel May Kennon
