With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of our beloved son, brother, grandson, nephew, cousin, and friend, Isaiah Jordon "Tunie" Bejarano, who entered into eternal rest on August 2, 2026, at the age of 28, in Hagerman, New Mexico.

Isaiah was born on April 4, 1998, to Conrado Bejarano II and Nancy A. Becerra. He was raised in Hagerman, New Mexico, where he attended and graduated from Hagerman High School. He was a faithful member of Church on the Move in Roswell, where his faith remained an important part of his life. To his family, he wasn't just Isaiah—he was "Tunie," a nickname lovingly given to him by his Tata that stayed with him throughout his life. Though naturally quiet and reserved, Tunie had a personality that shined brightest around those he loved. He could be stubborn, funny, and always managed to make his family laugh. The moments he treasured most were the ones spent with his brothers, sisters, and loved ones. Whenever they were all together, that's

when he was happiest. Those gatherings became some of life's most treasured memories.

Isaiah appreciated the simple things in life. He loved listening to music, taking drives through the country, spending time outdoors, and enjoying the peace and quiet. He didn't have a favorite song—he simply loved music. Whether he was riding through the back roads or sitting quietly, music was always something that brought him comfort.

A gifted athlete, Isaiah excelled in both football and basketball. His determination, speed, and relentless work ethic helped Hagerman High School capture the 2013 New Mexico 2A Football State Championship and the 2014 New Mexico 1A Boys Basketball State Championship. Whether on the football field or the basketball court, he gave everything he had, earning the respect of teammates, coaches, and everyone who had the privilege of watching him compete.

While his accomplishments in athletics were remarkable, they never defined him. Those who loved Isaiah will remember his gentle heart, his quiet strength, his unwavering loyalty, and the love he had for his family. He never needed to be the loudest person in the room to make an impact. His presence alone brought comfort, and his absence has left a void that can never be filled. He taught us that love doesn't always have to be loud. Sometimes it is found in quiet moments, shared laughter, and simply being together. That is how we will remember Tunie—with a smile, a story, and the love that will forever keep him close to our hearts.

Isaiah is survived by his loving parents, Conrado Bejarano II and Nancy A. Becerra; his siblings, Isaac Bejarano (Brianna), RJ Rojo, Jazzlyn Gomez (Jose), and Arian C.
