The family of Jane Campos, age 79, is deeply saddened to announce her passing on July 26, 2026. Jane passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by the love of her family.

A beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, great-great-grandmother, sister, aunt, cousin, godmother, and friend, Jane touched countless lives with her warmth, strength, and unwavering faith. God called our beautiful mother home to eternal rest, leaving behind a legacy of love that will live on through the generations she so cherished. Blessed to witness five generations of her family, Jane's greatest joy was seeing her family grow. She will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved her.

Jane was born on December 30, 1946, in Roswell, New Mexico, to Sarah and Esequiel Horton-Chavez. She was raised on Mulberry Street alongside her eleven siblings in a close-knit family. She attended Catholic school with many neighborhood children and later completed her education by earning her GED in 1999, a personal accomplishment she was proud of.

During Christmas of 1962, Jane and a young man named Tito happened to ride together with friends on their way to Midnight Mass at St. John's Catholic

Church. That chance encounter began a lifelong love story. Jane married Tito M. Campos on August 10, 1963, at St. John's Catholic Church. Together they built a beautiful life centered on faith, family, and unconditional love. This August, they would have celebrated 63 years of marriage.

Together, Jane and Tito were blessed with three children: Pauline, Lisa, and Tito Joseph (TJ). Their family grew to include five grandchildren, thirteen great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren, each of whom brought Jane immense pride and happiness.

Jane dedicated more than twenty years of service to Levi Strauss in Roswell before retiring when the plant closed in 1997.

A lifelong member of St. John's Catholic Church, Jane's Catholic faith guided every aspect of her life. She faithfully volunteered at the church for many years and found great joy in serving her parish community.

Outside of church and family, Jane enjoyed many simple pleasures. She was a proud member of the Eagles and was especially known for her love of bingo. For Jane, bingo was never just about winning, it was about gathering with friends, playing cards or dominoes before the games, and enjoying time together. If anyone was looking for Mom during the week, chances were they would find her at bingo or visiting friends for a game of poker.

Jane also enjoyed bowling in a league with friends and looked forward to family vacations in Colorado each summer. Those trips were filled with camping, Fourth of July fireworks, laughter, and treasured memories shared with those she loved most.

Above all else, Jane's greatest love was her family. She fiercely protected and supported her children, grandchildren, and every member of her growing

family. Everyone knew one thing—don't mess with her kids.

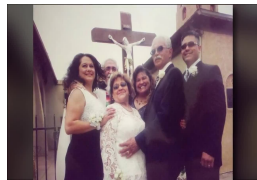
