



John Early Cannon

September 12, 1945 - July 18, 2019

Brother John Early Cannon age 73 of Roswell, New Mexico passed away on Thursday, July 18, 2019 with his family by his bedside. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, cousin and friend to many. We will celebrate John's life at 2pm Thursday, Aug. 1st, 2019 at Country Club Road Church of Christ at 700 W. Country Club Rd, Roswell, NM. Interment will follow at Douglas L. McBride Veterans Cemetery at South Park in Roswell, New Mexico.

A viewing will be held Wednesday, July 31st from 10am-7pm at Anderson Bethany Funeral Home.

John Early Cannon was born to Lincoln and Gertrude Cannon on September 12, 1945 in Fayette, Alabama. John received his secondary education from Davidson Christian Academy in Nashville, Tennessee where he received his high school diploma and biblical studies certificate in 1964. Following high school, John joined the United States Air Force and proudly served his country for 8 years. During John's military service, he was stationed at Walker Air Force Base in Roswell, New Mexico. It was there where he met his wife of 51 years Glory Dean Hall. The two were married August 30, 1967.

John was a proud proponent of education. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1979 and his Masters of Education in 1981 both from Eastern New Mexico University.

John's professional careers included the Roswell Job Corps, Captain at New Mexico Military Institute, and Federal Health Advisor at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Albuquerque, New Mexico. John was later transferred to assist in the opening of the VA Clinic in Artesia, New Mexico. While in Artesia, John assisted many veterans in obtaining much needed medical and financial benefits until his retirement in 1996.

John was an active and beloved member of the Roswell community and championed many organizations. John was gratified in memberships of Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion, Roswell Midday Lions Club, The Elks Lodge, and served as the Commander of Disabled American Veterans for a significant number of years.

John Early Cannon often stated that preaching GOD's word was his first love. He was very passionate and active in his ministry. His service to the church spanned over 5 decades while heading congregations in both Hobbs and Roswell, New Mexico. Brother John E. Cannon was the Minister of Elm Street Church of Christ in Roswell, New Mexico until his health began to fail him. John was also known to many as "Early," "Big John Cannon," "Mr. Biggs," "Pops," "Brotha Cannon," "Papaw," "GrandDad," and "Can-Can." John also loved to fish, hunt, and cook for family and friends.

We are so proud to have been blessed to have John Early Cannon in our lives for 73 years. Thank you for helping us celebrate a wonderful servant, man and life.

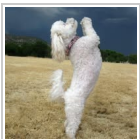
