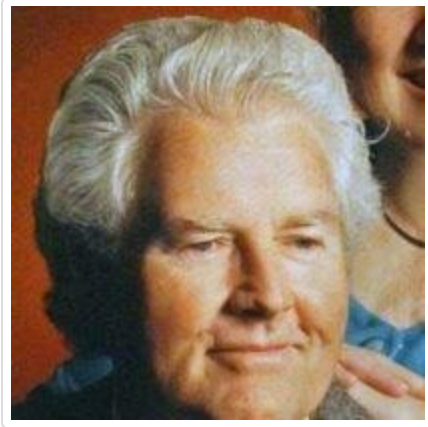




John Cecil Donahue Jr.
