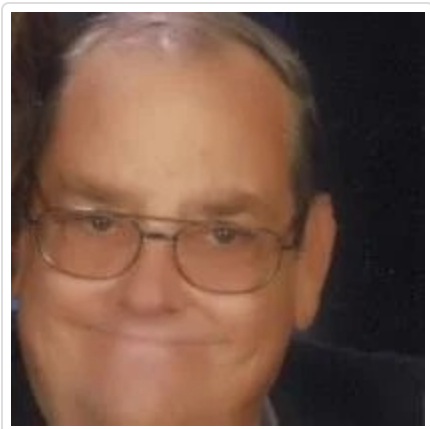




John Westfall

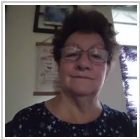

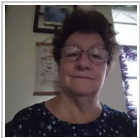
