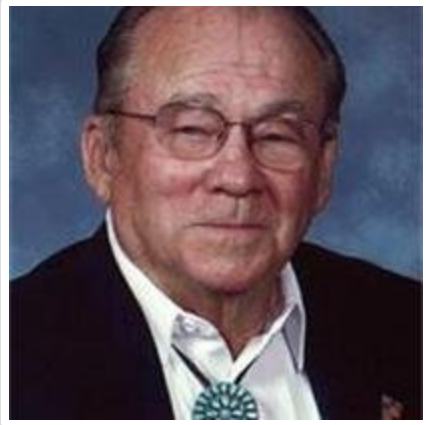




Lloyd Hubbard
