Manuel Canuto Gallegos was born in Raton, NM on September 28, 1937, to Frances Garcia Gallegos and Natividad Edwardo Gallegos, the tenth of thirteen children. He attended local schools and served in the U.S. Army before starting a family in Albuquerque and raising them in Central California in the 1960s and '70s. He relocated to his native New Mexico, where he met the love of his life, Betty, and they settled into their longtime Roswell home. Dad spoke fondly of his childhood in the mountains of northern New Mexico, and his desire to return home one day. He often shared many happy stories of when he was in the wilderness fishing and hunting with his brothers. Manuel became a friend of Bill in 1977 and eventually retired from his work as an auto mechanic, devoting the rest of his life to helping others build better lives. During the years after he became friends with Bill he took and helped his family and friends to better their life growing closer with his family and loved ones. He was a very strong man, but his home was opened to his grandkids who he loved, and they loved him. He showed them how to be respectful and how to love family.

Manuel is survived by his wife Betty; two sisters and two brothers; all his adult

children, including Mark, George, John, Cindy, Kaylee, Kenny, and Nicholas; and dogs: Highway and Daisy.

Manuel is preceded by his parents and eight siblings.
