Mark Stewart Earnest, 46, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, February 7, 2018, at the family home. On February 13, 1971, Mark was born in Roswell, NM, to Thomas and Maureen Earnest. He graduated from Roswell High School in 1989. At the age of 17, following graduation Mark enlisted in the US Army and became a Combat Medic with the First Cavalry Division. Thus, began a sterling military career that lasted over twenty years including five tours of duty in Iraq, Kuwait, Afghanistan and Saudi Arabia, and received numerous decorations, medal and commendations. In 2010, he was honorably discharged from the Army with the love and respect of many who served with him.

He married Susie Rodriguez on August 30, 2003, in Dexter, NM, after meeting each other at Sierra Fire Department, where they both volunteered.

Throughout Mark's life he was a Firefighter, EMT and Military Training Instructor, to name the few he was most proud of. He had an immense love for music and spending time with all his grandchildren and great-grandson. Mark made many friends thought his life and he cherished each individual memory he made with them. A member of Trinity United Methodist Church and Primera Iglesia Bautista of Dexter, Mark had a loving and generous heart
