Modeene Fivecoat was born on February 8, 1926, in Lake City, AR, to Claude Edgar Fivecoat and Ona May Lawson Fivecoat. The family moved to New Mexico when she was 8 years old for her health. They lived and worked on a farm in Dexter and she attended school there. Those were some of her happiest childhood years. Later, they moved to Roswell where she attended high school.

At a community dance, Modeene met her future husband, Doyle Howerton, Sr. They were married on May 21, 1941, in Lovington, NM. They were blessed with one son and four daughters. In 1997, they celebrated their 56th anniversary.
