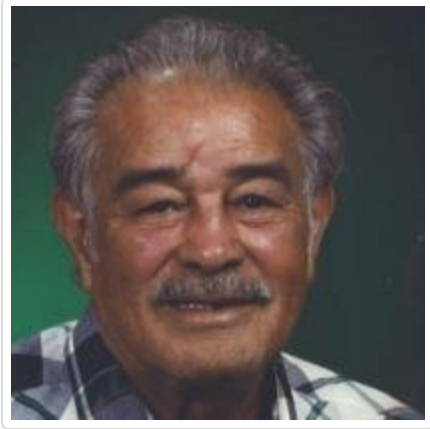




Ralph L Cobos
