On April 27, 1953, Richard was born to Richard Orlando Brady, Sr. and Beatrice Orona in Roswell, New Mexico. He attended Roswell schools and later enlisted in the United States Army, from 16 Nov 1971 to 17 Aug 1973, as a Lt. Truck Driver. During Richard's military service, he was awarded a National Defense Service Medal and Sharpshooter (M-16 Rifle). He was a proud Veteran whose heart was to serve his country. Richard worked as a truck driver for many years. He was of the Catholic faith and loved spending time with his family. Richard was a die-hard Las Vegas Raiders NFL fan. His favorite thing to watch wrestling and football, especially if his #1 football team was playing. Although Richard is no longer with us, the memory of him will live on in his family and all the friends he has left behind.
