Richard initially enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and continued serving his service in the United States Army. During Richard's military service, he was awarded a Presidential Unit Citation, Army Commendation Medal, Meritorious Medal, National Service Medal with Bronze Star, Special Forces, Ranger, Airborne, and many more. He was a proud Veteran whose heart was to serve his country. Richard retired from the Army and was honorably discharged after twenty-one years of active duty.

Richard was the beloved husband of Mary Dunbarr, whom he married on July 6, 1970, in Vacaville, California, and were together fifty golden years. After retiring from the military, he worked for the Postal Service. Richard was a

community Scout Master volunteer for the Boys Scouts. He was part of the Fraternal Order Police and Jewish Holocaust charities. Richard enjoyed fishing, woodworking and cooking, especially for the holidays. He loved working in the garden with his fruits and veggies. Richard was dearly loved, and he will be missed by his family and friend.
