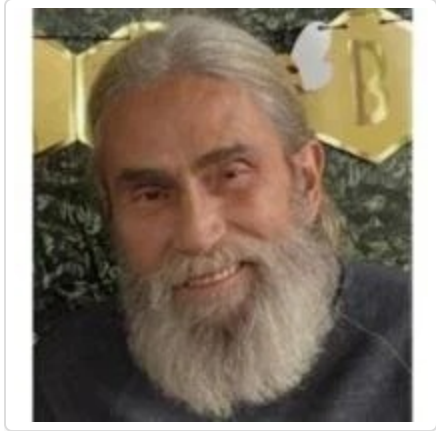




Robert W. Mitchell
