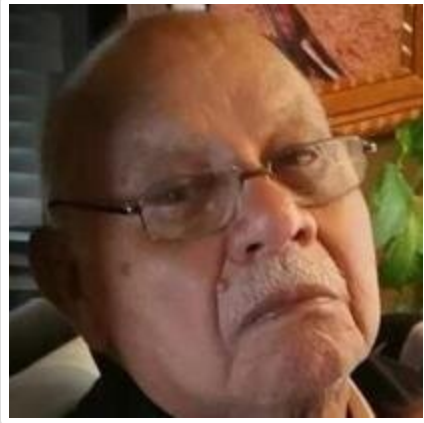




Samuel Niño
