Virgil enlisted into the United States Marine Corps on November 30, 1976. He was a Proof Technician Helper and a rifle and pistol sharpshooter. Virgil was Honorably discharged on March 31, 1978. God blessed Virgil with many skills and trades, such as car salesman, truck driver, and septic tank technician are just a few.

Living Life to the fullest, Virgil had many hobbies rebuilding a vehicle from the

ground up and putting his “Boopy” touches to enhance the ride. He played the saxophone in his early adult years and slid into home plate as a minor league baseball player in Roswell. Virgil held his “own” playing chess, and let’s not forget he was the Domino Master.
